Mayor's question time

On 3 May, the people of Lewisham elected Damien Egan to be their new Mayor.

Damien stood on a bold and radical manifesto to change our borough. Some of his priorities for the next four years include: improving our secondary schools while maintaining the standard of our primary schools and early years education; delivering 1,000 new social homes; developing a public health approach to youth violence; doubling the number of living wage employers in Lewisham; resisting any attempts to close Lewisham A&E or downgrade the hospital; and establishing a new greening fund to enhance our green spaces.



Since the election, Damien has hit the ground running. Some of the early actions he has taken include:

- Appointing Liane Segal, who escaped Nazi occupied Europe as a Kindertransport refugee, as Mayoress for Lewisham
- Announcing that we will bid for over £50 million from Sadiq Khan's housing fund to start delivering new social homes
- Being awarded £440,000 to plant new trees and restore the lake at Beckenham Place Park
- Starting the review of agency staff employed by the Council, with the aim of moving staff in-house

As part of our assembly meeting, Damien will be holding a Q&A for Forest Hill residents – come along on Tues 10 July 2018 to ask him a question, or hear more about his priorities for our borough.
